HOW TO ENTER **DEADLINE - FRIDAY, JUNE 14TH**

This is a FREE event for all artists. We have limited space to chalk, so you must register in advance. Participants will be provided with chalk, shade, lunch, snacks and water.

CATEGORIES

We will have two chalk painting areas, the Courthouse Square and Chalk Alley (Hamilton Street @ Broadway) for all types of artists/teams - novice to expert - plus high school students and 3rd-8th grade students. When filling out the Artist Registration Form please use the following definitions in determining which category of artist you are:

EXPERT ARTIST/TEAM

A person/team who has completed high quality artwork in a wide variety of chalk art/street painting festivals; regularly sells or displays their art; and/or, is employed and/or teaches in any area using skills in design, graphic development, etc., that can be related to "sidewalk chalking". PORTFOLIO/WEBSITE OF WORK REQUIRED FOR CONSIDERATION OF 12'x12' spaces.

***APPLICABLE CHALK AREA SIZES: 12' x 12', 10'x 10'**

INTERMEDIATE ARTIST/TEAM

A person/team who has completed quality artwork in several local or regional chalk art/street painting festivals; occasionally sells or displays their art; and/or has education, training, or regular practice in art/design skills.

***APPLICABLE CHALK AREA SIZES: 10'x 10', 6'x 6', 4'x 4'**

NOVICE ARTIST/TEAM

A person/team/families or budding artists. ***APPLICABLE CHALK AREA SIZES: 6'x 6', 4'x 4'**

STUDENTS (INDIVIDUAL OR TEAM)

HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS ***APPLICABLE CHALK AREA SIZES: 6'x 6', 4'x 4'**

3RD - 8TH GRADE STUDENTS (parent supervision is required) **APPLICABLE CHALK AREA SIZES: 3'x 3'**

****Square sizes are approximate and may slightly differ at event. Artists preferring a landscape or portrait area may "cut in" their square with tape available from the registration booth (and enjoy a little extra working room). If you have something unique in mind, select "other" and explain. Sizes and locations will be confirmed prior to the festival.***

NOTES

- All artists and team members must complete and sign a waiver at the event. Minors must have a parent or guardian available to sign a waiver at check in.
- If you would like to chalk next to another artist or artist group during the festival, please make that request on the note section of the registration form, and name the artist or team you would like to be next to. Festival organizers will do their best to honor such requests for artists who register at an early date.
